Principles of Church Discipline

<i>The keys of the kingdom</i> Gospel preaching <mark>[Mt. 16:18-19; John 20:21-23]</mark> Christian discipline <mark>[Mt. 18:17-18]</mark>
Who disciplines? Institute <mark>[Rev. 2:14,20; II Th. 3:14; I Cor. 5:4-5,13]</mark>
Who must be disciplined? The impenitent [Practices or doctrines] [II Tim 2:17f; II Th. 3:6f; Rev. 2:14; I Cor. 5:1]
Follow Mt. 18 Private & public sin Investigate [Dt. 17:4f] Not elders/minister first
Steps the church follows [CO Art. 76-77] Silent censure excomm.[Dt. 17:7; II Th. 3:14; I Cor. 5:2,13] God will guide His church [Mt. 18:20; Dt. 17:10-13]
One excommunicated = Delivered over to Satan Outside the church <mark>[I Cor. 5:5; I Tim. 1:20; II Cor. 6:14]</mark>
Why must we separate from impenitent? <mark>[I Cor. 5:9-11]</mark> That he may be ashamed [II Th. 3:14] Otherwise partake of it <mark>[II John 11-12; Ex. Form; Dt. 13:6,15]</mark>
Motivation = Love for God For the church [Num. 25:8; Achan; Rev. 2:14-16] For the brother [Lev. 19:16-18] Bring the Word; Don't respect persons [Dt. 16:19]
Steps of readmittance [CO 78] Consistory hears confession [Sees evidence] 1 st part [approbation] 2 nd part [LS service?]
